



Glass, Cans & Plastics



Aluminum and tin cans, glass bottles & jars, plastic containers & empty aerosol containers may be placed in the same container/bin. Recyclables must be clean and placed in a bin or container between 5 gallons and 32 gallons in size.

Newspaper, Cardboard & Mixed Paper



- Tie newspaper with twine in bundles no higher than 12". We cannot accept newspaper in bags, boxes or containers.
- We accept corrugated cardboard only if it is broken down and bundled. Please use twine whenever it is possible to do so.
- Magazines (tied in bundles), telephone books, mixed paper, envelopes, and junk mail must be placed in a brown paper bag and secured with twine.
